ITINERARY

Day 1: Monday 2 February 2026 – The Central Coast, Sydney, South Goulburn, Majura Park, Nimmitabel, Eden

Inclusions: Two-Course Alternate-Drop Dinner, 4-Star Accommodation, Portage

This morning, between 4.45am and 6.15am, you'll be collected from either outside or close to your home (this service will be available to most people living east of the Pacific Highway between Lake Munmorah and Kariong), and head to **Uncle Leo's Roadhouse**, near Glenfield. Upon arrival, you'll have time to enjoy a coffee and use the restrooms, before, at around 9.00am, departing on the **5-Star Luxury Coach** for your journey to the Far South Coast region of New South Wales. After departing from Uncle Leo's, you'll join the Hume Highway, and head straight to the famous **Trapper's Bakery**, in **South Goulburn**. After arriving at the Bakery at around 10.45am, you'll have time to enjoy a refreshment or two, prior to reboarding the coach at around 11.20am to head to **Majura Park Shopping Centre**, on the outskirts of Canberra. During your visit, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy lunch in one of the Centre's food outlets, and to stroll around this modern shopping centre. It is at this point that our Canberra and Queanbeyan-based Passengers will join the tour. You'll depart from here at around 1.30pm to head south on the Monaro Highway to the little town of **Nimmitabel**. After arriving here at around 3.30pm, you'll have around 45 minutes to enjoy a refreshment or two in either the famous Nimmitabel Bakery, or the nearby Berties Café, and take a quick stroll around the village, before departing at around 4.15pm to head straight to the newly renovated **Coachman's Eden Motel**, located on the outskirts of the far South Coast town of **Eden**. This lovely Motel will be your home for the next four nights. Set on two acres of land, the Motel features 26 comfortable rooms, a swimming pool, free WIFI, a restaurant, a bar, and reverse-cycle air-conditioning. All bathrooms feature a walk-in shower. Upon arrival, a porter has been organised to convey your luggage from the coach to your bedroom. After settling in and having time to freshen up, you'll make your way into the Motel's **Coachman's Restaurant**, where you'll sit down to a delicious **Two-Course Alternate-Drop Dinner**. For Main Course, you'll be served either Roast Lamb or Roast Beef, with Baked Potatoes, Baked Pumpkin, Cauliflower Cheese, Steamed Peas and Gravy. The Vegetarian option will be Wild Mushroom Risotto, with Salsa Verde and Shaved Parmesan. For Dessert, you'll be served either Eton Mess with Berries, a Berry Coulis, and Vanilla Ice-Cream, or Blueberry Cheesecake with a Berry Coulis and Vanilla Ice-Cream.

Day 2: Tuesday 3 February 2026 – Eden & Surrounds

Inclusions: Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast, Two-Hour Twofold Bay Morning Tea Cruise, Entry & Informative Talk at the Eden Killer Whale Museum, 1-Hour Guided Informative Tour of Eden, Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner, 4-Star Accommodation

This morning, between 7.30am and 8.45am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** in the Motel's **Coachman's Restaurant**, prior to boarding the coach at around 9.15am to head to the nearby **Eden Visitor Information Centre**. The Centre is housed inside the award-winning architecturally designed Eden Welcome Centre, at Snug Cove. Opened in 2021, this striking building is a unique addition to Eden's waterfront, constructed with recycled timber, sourced from all across New South Wales and Victoria, and showcasing a maritime walkway harbourside, and indigenous etchings on the building's exterior. The Visitor Centre takes up the ground floor of the building, and offers a carefully curated selection of local products, including books, jewellery, homewares, souvenirs, and pantry items. Upon arrival, you'll have over 30 minutes to browse in the Centre, prior to making your way along the walkway to the nearby wharf, where you'll board the modern 100-seat catamaran, operated by Sapphire Coastal Adventures, for a **Two-Hour Twofold Bay Morning Tea Cruise**. Twofold Bay covers an area of over 30 square kilometres, with two distinct bights, Calle Calle Bay and Nullica Bay. Beowa National Park (formerly Ben Boyd National Park) fringes the southern edge of the bay, and Balawan (Mount Imlay) is located to the southwest. The Bay features stunning scenery, pristine bays, and remote beaches, as well as an abundance of wildlife. If you're fortunate, you may get to see some of the Bay's resident dolphins and seals, and occasionally, other marine creatures such as penguins, flying fish, turtles and sharks make an appearance! The cruise will highlight the history of this former whaling port, and will include information about points of interest such as Boyd's Tower, the Seahorse Inn at Boydtown, Edrom Lodge, and the various whaling station sites. The naval wharf, woodchip mill, mussel farms, Quarantine Bay, and the fishing fleet will also be visible during the trip around the Bay. At some point after the vessel departs from the wharf, Morning Tea will be served, consisting of Self-Serve Tea or Coffee, and a selection of Biscuits and Slices. The vessel will return to the wharf at around 12.30pm, where you'll reboard the coach to head into **Eden Shopping Centre**. After arriving in the Shopping Centre, you'll have around 90 minutes of free time to browse in some of the main street's interesting shops, and enjoy lunch in one of the town's cafes, bakeries or hotels. Martins Pie Place is known for its range of delicious pies and sausage rolls, and for its old-fashioned cakes, slices, tarts and more! You'll depart from the Shopping Centre at around 2.25pm, for the short drive to the recently renovated **Eden Killer Whale Museum**. This popular Museum has been in operation for over 90 years, and houses over 10,000 artefacts. It features exhibits about the shore-based whaling operations in Twofold Bay during the 1800s and early 1900s, and includes a full skeleton of 'Tom'; the legendary Orca Killer Whale. This Whale led a pack of Killer Whales in the hunt for Baleen Whales on their southward migration each year. There is also an exhibition relating to the involvement of local indigenous Australians in shore-based whaling. The Museum also houses a full-scale model of the type of whale boat used in whale chases out of Twofold Bay. Exhibitions depicting the local fishing and timber industry tell of the extremely important role that these industries had, and continue to have, in the Eden community. Upon arrival, you'll be given an **Informative Talk** about the Museum by one of the Museum's knowledgeable volunteer guides. You'll then have free time to wander through the Museum, and to visit the Museum's exciting Gift Shop. After departing from the complex at around 3.45pm, you'll head back to the Eden Visitor Information Centre, where a local Tour Guide will board the coach, and take you on a **60-Minute Informative Guided Tour of Eden**. During the Tour, the Guide will point out buildings and places of historical and cultural significance, and provide you with an abundance of information about the town, its history, and attractions. At the completion of the Guided Tour, you'll arrive back at the Motel at around 5.10pm. You'll have time to relax and freshen up prior to making your way into the Motel's **Coachman's Restaurant**, where you'll sit down to a delicious **Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner**. For Main Course, you'll have the choice of either Chicken Breast, served with Baked Potatoes, Baked Sweet Potato, Steamed Greens and a Creamy Dijon Mustard Sauce, or Pan-Fried Salmon Fillet, served with Baked Potatoes, Baked Sweet Potato, Steamed Greens, and Hollandaise Sauce. The Vegetarian option tonight will be Fried Gnocchi with Roasted Pumpkin, Pine Nuts, and Sun-Dried Tomato. For Dessert you'll have the choice of either Bread & Butter Pudding, served with Custard and Vanilla Ice-Cream, or Freshly-Chopped Fruit Salad, served with Vanilla Ice-Cream.

Day 3: Wednesday 4 February 2026 – Eden, Merimbula, Candelo, Pambula, Eden

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast, Morning Tea, Entry & Guided Tour at Merimbula Aquarium, Pre-Dinner Drinks and Full Choice of the Menu Dinner at Eden Sports & Recreation Club, 4-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 7.00am and 8.15am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** in the Motel's **Coachman's Restaurant**, prior to boarding the coach to head to **Merimbula Aquarium & Wharf Restaurant**. This complex, located on the shoreline of Merimbula Bay, houses a 70,000 litre Oceanarium, and 28 tanks featuring both local and tropical marine life, including sharks, shrimps, octopus, tropical fish, and much more! Upon arrival, you'll sit down to a delicious **Morning Tea**, consisting of freshly-baked Scones, with Strawberry Jam and freshly-whipped Cream, along with Self-Serve Tea and Coffee. Following Morning Tea, you'll be escorted into the Aquarium, where you'll be taken on a **45-Minute Guided Tour**. You'll then have time to browse through the wonderful gift shop, before reboarding the coach at around 11.00am to head to **Merimbula Shopping Centre**. This delightful seaside shopping centre is packed with a range of interesting and unique shops - from clothing to footwear, fishing to sports gear, lollies, gifts, home-wares, books, jewellery and much, much more! You can spend your time browsing through the lovely shops, sit in a café or coffee shop at the water's edge and watch the world go by, stroll along the shoreline, enjoy lunch in one of the town's cafes, coffee shops, hotels or restaurants – the time is yours to do as you please! You'll depart from Merimbula Shopping Centre at around 1.00pm to head to the quaint little village of **Candelo**. With a population of just 300, this picturesque village is situated on the banks of the Candelo River, amongst lush, rich farmland, that is home to both dairy and beef cattle. Built during the 1830s, around the crossroads of Merimbula, Bega and Bombala, the village is best known for its nineteenth century buildings, verandahs, and old-world charm. You'll have around 40 minutes to stroll through the village, and pop into General Store for a refreshment or two. After departing from Candelo at around 2.15pm, you'll head to **Oaklands Barn**, located on the outskirts of the little town of Pambula. This exciting complex houses a number of businesses, including *Longstocking Brewery* – home to a range of Beer, Cider, Ginger Beer, Passion Fruit Sour, and more; *Waratah Chocolate & Ice-Creamery* – home to an exciting range of handmade chocolate bars and chocolate products, made from the finest Belgian ingredients, and a tempting range of boutique Ice-Cream; *The Village Gallery* – home to a stunning range of artworks, pottery, ceramics, homewares, jewellery and woodwork items; *Oaklands Café* – known for delicious breakfasts, lunches, sweet treats and more; *Oaklands Garden Centre & Gift Shop* – home to a huge range of homewares, books, plants, trees, garden tools, garden products, landscaping requirements, jams, sauces, honey, and much more! You'll have over an hour to browse and shop in this complex, prior to reboarding the coach at around 4.15pm, to head to **Eden Lookout**, which is perched on top of the ragged rocks of a roughly 380-million-year-old headland, called Middle Head. Upon arrival, you'll have around 20 minutes to take in the stunning views of Twofold Bay and the surrounding area. After visiting the Lookout, you'll head straight to the **Eden Sports & Recreation Club**, where you'll enjoy an included **Full Choice of the Menu Dinner**. The Bistro's menu features a large range of both Australian and Chinese cuisine options. A range of Dessert options are also available, should you still have some room left after completing your main course. At around 7.00pm, you'll reboard the coach, and head back to the Motel. For those who are fit, and want to walk off their dinner, you're welcome to make your own way back to the Motel, which is about a 7-minute walk from the Club.

Day 4: Thursday 5 February 2026 – Eden, Bega, Cabargo, Bermagui, Tathra, Eden

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast, Morning Tea, Afternoon Drinks at Tathra Hotel, Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner, 4-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 7.00am and 8.30am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** in the Motel's **Coachman's Restaurant**, prior to boarding the coach to head to the **Bega Cheese Heritage Centre**, which is located on the outskirts of the town of Bega. Situated adjacent to the famous Bega Cheese Factory, the Centre, built in 1993, is a faithful reconstruction of the original 'Creamery' building that was constructed as part of the Factory in 1899. Unfortunately, public tours are no longer permitted in the Factory, so the Centre is used to tell the story about Bega Cheese, and the history of the Factory. The Centre houses a small Museum, which tells the history of dairying in the Bega Valley, and contains equipment that was used in local dairy farms during the early 1900s. The Centre also features 'The Spotted Cow Gallery', which houses the work of local artisans, such as paintings, woodwork, leadlighting and other decorative arts. The Centre's Gift Shop houses a large range of souvenirs, farm-themed giftware, as well as local jams, preserves, honey, and much more! Of course, one of the most important products on sale is Bega's famous Cheese! You'll be able to sample a range of the cheese, including varieties that are only made for export, and are not sold in shops in Australia. Upon arrival, you'll sit down to a delicious **Morning Tea**, consisting of platters containing a range of biscuits, muffins, cakes and slices, as well as Self-Serve Tea & Coffee. Following Morning Tea, you'll have time to browse in the Museum, view an informative 20-minute video about the Factory and its history, and to shop in the fabulous 'Spotted Cow Gallery' and the Centre's Gift Shop. You'll depart from this complex at around 11.15am, and head to the charming little town of **Cabargo**. On the 31st of December, 2019, the village was ravaged by a huge bushfire that left the town devastated. Four local people, including a well-known father and son, lost their lives, and many of the village's houses and shops were virtually wiped off the face of the earth. In the time since the fire, most of buildings that were lost have been rebuilt, and the town, again, houses a wonderful range of fascinating and interesting shops, boutiques and galleries. These shops feature products such as art, craft, fashion, jewellery, pottery, leather goods, vintage items, second hand and antique items, and much more! It is not rare to see artisans working on their products in a number of the shops. There are a number of eating establishments in the village, should you require a refreshment or two during your visit. You'll depart from the village at around 1.00pm, to head to the little town of **Bermagui**. This picturesque seaside resort is famous for its deep sea and game fishing, including yellow fin tuna and marlin, as well as estuary fishing in the surrounding rivers and lakes. The little shopping centre has a lovely range of shops packed with fashion, jewellery, gifts, homewares, home décor and much more! During your visit, you'll have sufficient time to enjoy lunch in one of the town's many cafes or coffee shops. If it's a nice day, you may wish to purchase fish and chips and sit on the banks of the river to enjoy the atmosphere. After departing from Bermagui at around 2.30pm, you'll head straight to the **Tathra Hotel**. This recently renovated Hotel, situated on top of Tathra Headland, offers sweeping views over the nearby Pacific Ocean. Upon arrival, you'll have around an hour to enjoy two rounds of included **Afternoon Drinks** (soft drinks, beer, wine, spirits and cocktails), stroll to the adjacent lookout points, and if you're feeling fit enough, to walk down to the nearby Tathra Wharf. You'll depart from the Hotel at around 4.15pm, and return to the Motel at around 5.00pm. After having time to relax and freshen up, you'll make your way into the Motel's **Coachman's Restaurant**, where you'll sit down to a delicious **Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner**. For Main Course, you'll have the choice of either Rosemary Lamb Rump, served on Sweet Potato Mash, with Steamed Greens and a Red Wine Jus, or Barramundi, served on Sweet Potato Mash, with Steamed Greens and a Lemon Beurre Blanc. Tonight's Vegetarian option will be Roasted Pumpkin, Feta and Sage open Ravioli, with Shaved Parmesan. For Dessert you'll have the choice of either White Chocolate & Raspberry Cheesecake, with a Berry Coulis and Vanilla Ice-Cream, or Freshly-Chopped Fruit Salad, served with Vanilla Ice-Cream.

Day 5: Friday 6 February 2026 – Eden, Central Tilba, Mogo, Braidwood, South Goulburn, Sydney, The Central Coast

Inclusions: Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast, Portage

This morning, between 6.30am and 7.30am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** in the Motel's **Coachman's Restaurant**, prior to boarding the coach and saying farewell to the Motel and Eden. First stop will be the charming little village of **Central Tilba**. Set against the magnificent backdrop of Mt Dromedary, this quaint village is a perfectly restored and maintained period village, protected by National Heritage listing. The village features a host of unique shops and galleries, showcasing antiques, collectables, craft, art, textiles, estate and contemporary jewellery, fashion, leatherwork, candles, books, woodwork, homewares, gifts, and much, much more! Upon arrival, the coach will drop you off at the top of the village. You'll have around 90 minutes to stroll through the delightful shopping centre, and to enjoy a refreshment or two in one of the village's many eating establishments. Be sure to visit the Post Office! Upon opening the door, you'll see it is far, far more than a Post Office! A visit to this shop is a must for any visitor to the village! If you're feeling fit, why not make your way down to the end of the village and visit the Central Tilba ABC Cheese Factory. Just remember, it's an uphill walk back to where you disembarked from the coach at the beginning of your visit to the village! Although members of the general public are not permitted to visit the Factory, the Factory's shop is open to the public! Established in 1891, the Factory is still known for its famous Tilba Club Cheese. During your visit, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy a free Cheese Tasting, as well as taste a range of Honey produced on the South Coast. The shop also features a range of local produce, including jams and preserves, souvenirs, gifts, coffee and ice-cream. After reboarding the coach at around 11.00am, you'll head to the quaint shopping village of **Mogo**. This small village features shops filled with art, craft, books, ceramics, home décor, collectables, antiques, fashion, jewellery, candles, timber products, chocolates, lollies, fudge, gelato and much more! During your visit, it would be a good idea to have lunch in one of the village's eating venues, as your next opportunity to purchase a refreshment won't be until after 2.00pm. After having over an hour to stroll around the shopping centre and browse in the shops, you'll reboard the coach at around 1.15pm. After passing through Batemans Bay, and heading up Clyde Mountain, you'll arrive in the busy Southern Tablelands town of **Braidwood** at around 2.15pm. Located on the Kings Highway, between Batemans Bay and Canberra, this National Trust classified town is best known for its charming colonial buildings, rustic streetscapes and rural beauty. The town is packed with a range of interesting shops and quirky boutiques, and is a creative hub for artists, designers and craftspeople. Unfortunately, due to time constraints, you'll only have around 45 minutes in the town, however, the coach will drop you off close to the main street, so you'll have time to enjoy a quick stroll and browse during your visit. At the completion of your visit to Braidwood, a luxury Feeder Vehicle will arrive to collect our Canberra and Queanbeyan-based Passengers, to take them back to their homes. After departing from Braidwood at around 3.00pm, the coach will stop briefly in the little town of Tarago, to drop off Passengers who live in the area, prior to continuing on to **Tappers Bakery** in **South Goulburn**, for another rest and refreshment stop. You'll depart from here at around 4.30pm to head straight to **Uncle Leo's Roadhouse**, near Crossroads, on the outskirts of Sydney, where you'll have the opportunity for a quick rest stop, prior to boarding a Feeder Vehicle to be conveyed back to where you joined the tour last Monday morning. Most Central Coast-based passengers will return to their homes between 8.45pm and 10.15pm.
