ITINERARY

Day 1: Sunday 12 February 2023 – Queanbeyan, Canberra, Mittagong, Kangaroo Valley, Illaroo, Worrige
Inclusions: Morning Tea, Entry & Informative Guided Tour of Bundanon Homestead & Arthur Boyd's Studio, Entry to Bundanon Art Museum, Two-Course Generous-Serve Alternate-Drop Dinner, 4-Star Accommodation

This morning, between 6.30am and 7.45am, you'll board a Feeder Vehicle either outside your home, or close to your home, and be conveyed to **Mittagong RSL Club**, in the Southern Highlands. Upon arrival, you'll be served **Morning Tea**, consisting of Self-Serve Tea or Coffee and Freshly-Baked Scones with Strawberry Jam and Whipped Cream. Following Morning Tea, you'll board the **Main Luxury Coach**, and depart from the Club at around 11.00am, to head to the picturesque town of **Kangaroo Valley**. Upon arrival you'll have over an hour of free time to stroll around this interesting little shopping centre. The town houses shops packed with arts, craft, chocolates, lollies, antiques, collectables, fashion, jewellery, home décor items and much more! As you'll be visiting the village around lunchtime, there are a number of food venue options, including 'The Friendly Inn Hotel', one of the region's oldest pubs - a favourite with both locals and visitors. You'll depart from Kangaroo Valley Shopping Centre at around 1.15pm to head to **Bundanon Homestead**. Situated in 1,000 hectares of pristine bushland, overlooking the Shoalhaven River, in the locality of Illaroo, about 25 kilometres from Nowra, this imposing two-storey sandstone homestead, made of locally quarried stone, was completed in 1866. The Homestead features timber verandahs, and is now listed on the Register of the National Estate. In 1979, the famous Australian painter, Arthur Boyd, purchased the property, set up his studio, and went on to create many of his unique and fascinating pieces of art. Boyd shared the home with both up and coming and reputable artists, such as his brother-in-law, Sidney Nolan. In 1993, he and his wife, Yvonne, gifted the home to the Australian people. Following this selfless act, Bundanon Trust was formed. The Trust supports the development of arts practice across all disciplines, through its artist in residence program. It operates a residential education program for children and adults, and presents a dynamic, on-site public program, including concerts and special events, open days and group visits. Bundanon Trust is a custodian of the Boyd family art collection, the historic Bundanon Homestead, and Arthur Boyd's studio. After arriving at around 2.00pm, you'll be taken on a **45-Minute Guided Tour** of the Homestead and Studio. After completing your visit to the Homestead, you'll reboard the coach for your 20-minute journey through bushland, to the **Bundanon Art Museum**. This stunning new \$36million art gallery, housing works by not only Boyd, but also artists such as Sidney Nolan, John Perceval, Charles Blackman, and many others, was opened a few months ago on the 5th of March, 2022. Perched on the shores of the Shoalhaven River, with the Morton National Park as a backdrop, the gallery now houses around 3,800 works of art, including paintings, sculptures, ceramics and archival photographs, valued at over \$40million. Upon arrival at the Gallery, you'll have nearly an hour to browse the various exhibits. You'll depart from the Gallery at around 4.45pm, to head to **Springs Shoalhaven Resort**, on the outskirts of the little village of **Worrige**, near Nowra. This impressive two-level, 46-room Resort, situated on the 18-hole Worrige Links Golf Course, and adjacent to the Worrige Sports Club, offers stunning views over the Golf Course and nearby escarpment. Upon arrival, you'll make your way straight to your comfortable and well-appointed room, complete with walk-in showers, to wait for a porter to deliver your luggage to your room. After having time to relax and freshen up, you'll make your way next door to the **Worrige Sports Club**, where you'll sit down to a delicious **Two-Course Generous-Serve Alternate-Drop Dinner**. For Main Course you'll be served either Roast Lamb with Baked Vegetables, Cauliflower Cheese, Steamed Greens and Gravy or Roast Beef with Baked Vegetables, Cauliflower Cheese, Steamed Greens and Gravy. For Dessert you'll be served either Sticky Date Pudding with Butterscotch Sauce and Vanilla Ice-Cream, or Plain Cheesecake with Berries, a Berry Coulis and Vanilla Ice-Cream.

Day 2: Monday 13 February 2023 – Worrige, Huskisson, Berry, Worrige
Inclusions: Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, 1.5-Hour Jervis Bay Dolphin Watch Cruise, Multi-Choice Dinner, 4-Star Accommodation

After waking, you'll make your way to the adjacent **Worrige Sports Club**, where you'll sit down to a delicious full **Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast**. At around 9.00am you'll board the coach to head straight to the seaside resort of **Huskisson**. After arriving in the town, you'll board the 'Tekin III – The Spirit of Jervis Bay' for a **90-Minute Jervis Bay Dolphin Watch Cruise**. This specially designed 17-metre catamaran boasts five separate viewing platforms, including a 360 degree sundeck, and has the advantage of having up to 80% of its viewing platforms undercover, which offers protection from both the sun and certain weather conditions. During your cruise around the Bay, you'll be given professional commentary. Throughout the year, Jervis Bay plays host to a resident pod of between 80 and 120 Bottle Nose Dolphins. At certain times of the year, the Dolphin population swells with a visit from a school of Common Dolphins, as they make their way up and down the coast. After returning to the wharf at around 12.00pm, you'll have around 90 minutes of free time to stroll through the lovely **Huskisson Shopping Centre**, which is packed with a range of interesting shops and cafes. You'll reboard the coach at around 1.30pm, and head to the very popular town of **Berry**. Originally known as Broughton Creek, the town's name was changed to "Berry", to honour Alexander Berry, who had established the nearby Coolangatta Estate in the 1820s. The town is packed with shops filled with craft, arts, gifts, fashion, jewellery, antiques, plants, produce, chocolates, fudge, gelato, and much more! Upon arrival, you'll have over an hour to stroll, browse, and if you're tempted, to make a purchase or two, as well! After departing from Berry at around 3.30pm, you'll head to the nearby **Berry Treat Factory**. Promoted as 'The Complete Food Experience', this complex is packed with a huge range of handmade chocolates and confectionary, and over 200 varieties of exquisite products, including Butters, Chutneys, Relishes, Dressings, Vinegars, Jams, Jellies, Marmalades, Mustards, Aioli, Tapenades, Pasta Sauces, Pates, Pastes, Sweet Sauces, Savoury Sauces, Chocolate Sauces, Syrups, Salt, Spice Blends, Dukkah, Teas, and much, much more! Prior to departing from the complex, why not pop next door to 'The Dairy Bar' where you can try a tempting Gelato, made at the adjacent South Coast Dairy, from award-winning milk and cream. After stocking up with chocolate and lollies, you'll reboard the coach to return to the Resort. After returning to the Resort at around 5.00pm, you'll have time to relax in your room, prior to making your way next door to the **Worrige Sports Club**, for Dinner. Tonight, you can have whatever you'd like from the menu. The menu features items such as Fish, Steak, Pastas, Gnocchi, Pizzas, Salads, Beef or Chicken Burgers, Desserts and much more!

Day 3: Tuesday 14 February 2023 – Worrigeer, Milton, Moruya, Mogo, Batemans Bay

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, Two-Course Generous-Serve Pre-Ordered Dinner, 4-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 7.30am and 8.30am, your full **Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** will be served, next door, in **Worrigeer Sports Club**. After returning to your room to pack, at around 9.00am you'll board the coach, say "goodbye" to the Resort and Worrigeer, and head to the picturesque town of **Milton**. This delightful town is known for its wonderful range of galleries, antique outlets, fashion boutiques, arts & craft shops, home furnishing & décor outlets, and much more! The town is also home to a variety of coffee shops, alfresco cafes, and various other eating establishments. So, if wish to enjoy a refreshment during your visit, you'll have plenty of options available! After having over an hour to stroll through the Shopping Centre, you'll reboard the coach at around 11.00am, to head to the town of **Moruya**. About 25 kilometres south of Batemans Bay, Moruya is primarily a service centre for a rich rural area known for its dairies, cattle, vegetables, fish and oysters. Upon arrival, you'll have around 90 minutes to stroll through the bustling shopping centre, and to enjoy lunch in one of the town's cafes or coffee shops. Before departing from the town, be sure to check out the large wood carving by internationally recognised wood carver, Bryan Carrick. This carving stands outside the Air Raid Tavern in Vulcan Street (the main street). Titled "The Airman", it stands three metres tall and was modelled on the World War II Dutch aviator Gus Winkel. It honours the "allied aircrew, ground support and ancillary staff who operated from Moruya airfield during the war years". At around 1.45pm, you'll reboard the coach to head to the quaint shopping village of **Mogo**. This small village features shops filled with art, craft, books, ceramics, home décor, collectables, antiques, fashion, jewellery, candles, timber products, chocolates, fudge, gelato and much more! After having around an hour to stroll around the shopping centre, and to browse in the shops, you'll reboard the coach and head to **Batemans Bay Town Centre**. You'll be dropped off close to the Clyde River, the shops in the main street, as well as the two nearby shopping malls. This will provide you with a choice – to stroll along the river front to take in the picturesque scenery, or to hit the air-conditioned shops and shopping malls, to browse and perhaps make a purchase or two. You'll depart from Batemans Bay Town Centre at around 4.30pm, and some five or so minutes later you'll arrive at the **Sunseeker Motor Inn** – your home for the next two nights. This very comfortable 4-Star Motor Inn boasts stair-free access to all rooms, walk-in showers, air-conditioning, a swimming pool, and an excellent restaurant. A short time after you arrive in your room, your luggage will be delivered by one of the Motor Inn's staff members. You'll have time to relax prior to making your way into the Motor Inn's "**Trappers Restaurant**" by 6.00pm, where you'll sit down to a delicious **Two-Course Generous-Serve Pre-Ordered Dinner**. For Main Course you'll have the choice of either Pan-Fried Prosciutto-Wrapped Chicken Breast, stuffed with Quince Paste and sautéed Leek & Thyme, served with roast Chat Potatoes, sautéed Broccolini, and a Port Demi Glaze, or Slow Cooked Beef Cheeks with Celeriac Puree, glazed turned Carrot, Green Beans, dehydrated Tomato, and a Blueberry Demi Glaze, or Grilled Tasmanian Atlantic Salmon with crispy Skin, smashed Chat Potatoes, sautéed Greens, and a Lemon Butter Sauce. For Dessert you'll have the choice of either Banoffee Stack with Short Crust Biscuit, Crème Pâtissière, Banana, Caramel Sauce, and Meringue, or Pecan & Medjool Date Tart with Hazelnut Frangipane, Fig, and Rock Salt Caramel Ice-Cream, or Apple Tarte Tatin with Cinnamon Crème Anglaise, Butterscotch Sauce, and Vanilla Bean Ice-Cream.

Day 4: Wednesday 15 February – Batemans Bay, Central Tilba, Bermagui, Cobargo, Tuross, Batemans Bay

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, Three-Hour Clyde River Buffet Dinner Cruise, 4-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 6.45am and 7.45am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Breakfast** in the Motor Inn's "Trappers Restaurant", prior to boarding the coach at 8.00am, to head to the picturesque village of **Central Tilba**. Set against the magnificent backdrop of Mt Dromedary, this quaint village is a perfectly restored and maintained period village, protected by National Heritage listing. The village features a host of unique shops and galleries, showcasing antiques, collectables, craft, art, textiles, estate and contemporary jewellery, fashion, leatherwork, candles, books, woodwork, homewares, gifts, and much, much more! Upon arrival, the coach will drop you off at the top of the village. At the conclusion of your visit, you are to reboard the coach at the bottom of the village. You'll have around 90 minutes to stroll through the delightful shopping centre, and to enjoy some refreshments in one of the village's many eating establishments. Be sure to visit the Post Office! Upon opening the door, you'll see it is far, far more than a Post Office! A visit to this shop is a must for any visitor to the village! At the completion of your stroll through the village, you'll arrive at the **Central Tilba ABC Cheese Factory**. This is where the coach will be waiting for you to reboard. Although members of the general public are not permitted to visit the Factory, they are most welcome to visit the Factory's interesting shop! Established in 1891, the Factory is still known for its famous Tilba Club Cheese. During your visit, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy a free Cheese Tasting, as well as taste the largest range of Honey produced on the South Coast. The shop also features a range of local produce, including jams and preserves, as well as souvenirs, gifts, coffee and ice-cream. After reboarding the coach at this point at around 11.15am, you'll depart from the village and head straight to the pretty seaside town of **Bermagui**. This town is famous for its deep sea and game fishing, including yellow fin tuna and marlin, as well as estuary fishing in the surrounding rivers and lakes. The little shopping centre has a lovely range of shops packed with fashion, jewellery, gifts, homewares, home décor and much more! During your visit you'll have sufficient time to enjoy lunch in one of the town's many cafes or coffee shops. If it's a nice day, you may wish to purchase fish and chips and sit on the banks of the river to enjoy the atmosphere. You'll depart from Bermagui at around 12.45pm to head to the lovely little village of **Cobargo**. On the 31st of December, 2019, the village was ravaged by a huge bushfire that left the town devastated. Four local people, including a well-known father and son, lost their lives, and many of the village's houses and shops were virtually wiped off the face of the earth. The town is slowly rebuilding, and many of the shops have reopened. The shopkeepers are extremely keen to welcome visitors back to their village, so your visit is sure to be appreciated! A number of the shops are housed in turn-of-the-century buildings, which significantly adds to the atmosphere and ambiance of the village. These shops feature products such as art, craft, fashion, jewellery, pottery, leather goods, and much more! It is not rare to see artisans working on their products in a number of the shops. There are also a number of eating establishments in the village, should you require a refreshment or two during your visit. You'll depart from the village at around 2.15pm, to head to the famous **Tuross Boatshed & Café**, in **Tuross Head**. Located literally on the water, you'll have time to enjoy a coffee, cold drink or ice-cream, whilst taking in the surrounding picturesque views. You'll depart from the Boatshed at around 4.00pm, to return to the Sunseeker Motor Inn. Upon arrival, you'll have around 30 minutes to freshen up, prior to reboarding the coach for the five-minute journey to Batemans Bay wharf. After disembarking from the coach, you'll board "**The Escape**", operated by Merinda River Cruises, for a **Three-Hour Clyde River Buffet Dinner Cruise**. The impressive Buffet will consist of Fresh Prawns, Battered Fish, Crumbed Prawn Cutlets, Cold Meats, such as Ham, Corned Beef and BBQ Chicken, Garden Salad, Coleslaw, Potato Salad, and Potato Wedges. For Dessert, there'll be a selection of decadent Cakes, served with Whipped Cream. The vessel will return to the wharf at around 8.30pm, and after reboarding the coach, you'll arrive back at the Motor Inn at around 8.45pm.

Day 5: Thursday 16 February 2023 – Batemans Bay, Mogo Zoo, Ulladulla, Kiama, Mittagong, Canberra, Queanbeyan
Inclusions: Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, Entry into Mogo Zoo

This morning, between 6.45am and 8.15am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Breakfast** in the Motor Inn's "Trappers Restaurant" prior to boarding the coach, bidding farewell to the Motor Inn, and heading to the nearby **Mogo Zoo**. Located around 10 kilometres south of Batemans Bay, this award-winning privately owned Zoo features an amazing collection of endangered and exotic animal species; all housed among 81 acres of bushland and beautifully landscaped gardens. Home to around 250 animals, of which more than 44 varieties are rare of exotic species, the Zoo proudly boasts the largest collection of primates in Australia. You'll have the opportunity to view Zebras, Southern White Rhinos, Giraffes, Snow Leopards, Meerkats, Sumatran Tigers, White Lions, Deer, Ring-Tailed Lemurs, Nepalese Red Pandas, Silvery Gibbons, Cotton-Top Tamarins, Bolivian Squirrel Monkeys, Oriental Small-Clawed Otters, and many more! You'll arrive at the Zoo as the gates open at 9.00am, and have nearly two hours to browse around the animal exhibits, visit the coffee shop, as well as the interesting Gift Shop. You'll depart from the Zoo at around 10.45am, and head to the pretty seaside resort of **Ulladulla**. Historically Ulladulla was an important port for the local timber and dairy industry. Today the harbour is home to a fleet of commercial fishing trawlers but, increasingly, the town has become a coastal holiday resort and popular place for retirement. It is one of those rare places on the New South Wales coast where the main artery - the Princes Highway - actually passes close by the harbour, which is nestled between two enclosing headlands. On either side of the town there are holiday beaches, seven lakes, and in the hinterland, there are state forests, mountain ranges and national parkland, which are ideal for bushwalks and scenic drives. Upon arrival at around 11.45am, you'll have over an hour to explore the town. The bustling Shopping Centre houses a wide range of shops and boutiques. If you wish to enjoy lunch during your visit, you'll be spoilt for choice when it comes to finding an eating establishment. If seafood is your thing, and you feel like a nice serving of Fish & Chips, you may want to head to the café at "Fishermen's Wharf Seafood", which is located adjacent to the harbour. After departing from Ulladulla at around 1.00pm, you'll head north to the lovely seaside town of **Kiama**. After arriving at around 2.30pm, you'll have over an hour to stroll through the shopping centre, grab a drink or an ice-cream. Be sure to pop into the row of shops next to Hindmarsh Park, in Collins Street, just up from the Kiama Leagues Club. These shops are packed with a wonderful range of fashion, home décor items, jewellery and more! After reboarding the coach at around 3.45pm, you'll head to **Mittagong** for a quick rest stop. It is at this point that you'll say "goodbye" to the Sydney and Central Coast-based passengers, and board the Feeder Vehicle to be conveyed back to the point where you boarded last Sunday morning. Most passengers residing in Canberra and Queanbeyan will return home between 7.15pm and 8.30pm.
