Day 1: Saturday 2 December 2023 – Canberra, Queanbeyan, Sydney, Warners Bay, Newcastle, Williamtown Inclusions: Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner, 4.5-Star Accommodation

This morning, between 4.45am and 6.00am, passengers living in Queanbeyan and Canberra will be collected from either outside or close to their homes, before arriving at McDonalds in Lyneham, where they'll board the 5-Star Luxury Coach for their trip away. After departing from Lyneham you'll head to Trapper's Bakery, in South Goulburn, for a quick rest stop. From here, you'll head to the outer Sydney suburb of **Eastern Creek**, to collect the Sydney-based passengers, and to stretch your legs and enjoy a refreshment or two. You'll then head north to the picturesque coastal town of **Warners Bay**, located on the banks of Lake Macquarie. En-route, the coach will stop briefly to collect the Central Coast-based passengers. Upon arrival at around 1.00pm, you'll have time to enjoy lunch in one of the town's cafes or coffee shops, or perhaps, instead, you may like to purchase a serve of fish and chips and sit on a seat adjacent to the water's edge, and take in the picturesque scenery of this beautiful area. You'll reboard the coach at around 2.30pm, and head straight to the Honeysuckle area of Newcastle. This stunning 50 hectare residential and commercial development, on former industrial land, is situated on the foreshore of Newcastle Harbour. The suburb features modern apartments, office buildings, beautifully restored heritage-listed buildings, including the Newcastle Museum, and a host of eating establishments, many of which offer wonderful views of the Harbour. You'll have around an hour to stroll along the Foreshore, and enjoy the scenery, before reboarding the coach at around 4.00pm to head to the Mercure Newcastle Airport Hotel. This lovely 4.5-star Hotel, consisting of 90 rooms over four levels, was opened in 2015. Upon arrival you'll be given your room key so you can make your way straight to your modern, well-appointed room. Shortly after arriving in your room, a porter will deliver your luggage from the coach to your room. After having over an hour to relax and freshen up, you'll make your way into the Hotel's Mach One Restaurant, where you'll be served a delicious Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner. For Main Course you'll have the choice of either Grilled Barramundi Fillet with Lemon & Parsley Sauce, served with Potato Gratin & Steamed Seasonal Vegetables, or Sage and Onion Stuffed Chicken Breast with Caramelized Onion Gravy, accompanied by Garlic Roast Kipfler Potatoes and Steamed Seasonal Vegetables, or Beef Cheek, braised in Red Wine and Porcini Mushrooms, served with Paris Mash and Charred Brocolini. For Dessert you'll have the choice of either Lemongrass & Lime Leaf Crème Brulee, served with Vanilla Bean Ice Cream & Native Lemon Balm, or Salted Caramel Chocolate Tart, served with Orange Fruit Salad, Baby Meringues and Chantilly Cream, or House-made Custard Tart, served with fresh Raspberries and Raspberry Sorbet. Following Dinner, Tea & Coffee will be available.

Day 2: Sunday 3 December 2023 – Williamtown, Nelson Bay, Pokolbin, Williamtown

Inclusions: Hot & Cold Breakfast, 90-Minute Port Stephens Dolphin Watch Cruise, Morning Tea, Two-Course Full Choice of the Menu Dinner, Entry to Hunter Valley Gardens Christmas Lights, 4.5-star Accommodation

After enjoying a Hot & Cold Breakfast, you'll board the coach at around 8.45am and head straight to the picturesque coastal town of Nelson Bay. Upon arrival you'll board a modern catamaran operated by Moonshadow Cruises for a 90-Minute Port Stephens Dolphin Watch Cruise. Larger than Sydney Harbour, this pristine body of water is known for its herds of resident bottlenose dolphins. Bottlenose dolphins are sleek and streamlined, with a prominent, broad, triangular dorsal fin located in the middle of the back. They vary in size, shape and colour, but are generally dark on the back and light grey/white underside. This colouration assists in camouflage from their predators (sharks and killer whales). Looking up from below the light underside of a dolphin blends against the sky and from above the dark back merges with deep water below. As dolphins get older they may develop a white spot on their bottlenose. Dolphins range in weight from 90kg to 650kg, however, the average weight is around 200kg. During the cruise you'll be served a Morning Tea, consisting of Tea, Coffee, a Slice of Cake and a Biscuit. At the conclusion of the cruise you'll have around 90 minutes to stroll along the harbour foreshore, browse in some of the lovely boutiques and shops in the town, and to enjoy lunch in one of the town's many eating establishments. After departing from Nelson Bay you'll head to the nearby Treasure Emporium Christmas Store. This exciting pop-up store operates in the leadup to Christmas each year. From the moment you step into the store, you'll think you've entered another world. You'll be amazed at the range of products available. You'll have around 45 minutes to browse in the shop, prior to reboarding the coach to return to the Hotel by around 3.00pm. After returning to the Hotel you'll have around 11/2 hours to relax and maybe take a nap, prior to reboarding the coach at 4.30pm to head to The Mighty Hunter Valley Hotel, in Pokolbin, in the beautiful Hunter Valley. Upon arrival you'll enjoy a Two-Course Full Choice of the Menu Dinner. At around 7.00pm you'll then head down the road to visit the annual Christmas Lights Spectacular at Hunter Valley Gardens. After arriving at the Gardens you'll have time to visit the impressive Gift Shop, prior to heading into the Gardens to view the dazzling display of over 3 million lights. The Gardens are filled with not only colourful glowing well-known nursery rhyme and story book figures, but also rainbows, a giant lit Christmas Tree, Santa's Cave, and things typically Australian, such as the Harbour Bridge, Opera House, and various Australian animals. All these displays are located adjacent to a wheelchair-friendly network of well-maintained paths and walkways. You'll depart from the Gardens at around 9.00pm, to return to the Hotel by around 10.00pm.

Day 3: Monday 4 December 2023 – Williamtown, Thornton, Maitland, Williamtown

After enjoying a Hot & Cold Breakfast, you'll board the coach at around 9.00am and head to The Big UGG Boots at Mortels Sheepskin Factory, in Thornton. Mortels Sheepskin Factory is home to the world's biggest UGG Boots. These big UGG boots are 13 times the size of a women's size 8 UGG boot. The Big UGG Boots were erected on Monday the 20th April 2015. A day later, on Tuesday 21st April, the Hunter Region was ravaged by the equivalent of a category 2 Cyclone. This storm brought devastating winds and rains to the region. The Big UGG Boots, constructed from fibreglass and steel, weighing approximately 600 kilograms each, remained strong and fast despite the conditions immediately following their erection. Australia's iconic footwear are now a significant landmark, that offers a prime photo opportunity! Mortels have been manufacturing and retailing sheepskin products since 1958. Their product range includes UGG boots and slippers for women, men and children, rugs, home décor items, seat covers, pet gear, sheepskin clothing, vests, hats, and much more! Upon arrival you'll be taken into the Factory for a 45-Minute Guided Informative Tour. From a raised viewing platform, you'll experience the sights, sounds and smells of a fully operational manufacturing plant. You'll watch and learn about the making of Mortels UGG boots, from the raw materials used, through to the finished product. During your visit to the Factory you'll be served a Morning Tea, consisting of Tea, Coffee, and freshly-made Scones, served with Jam and Cream. Prior to departing from the Factory you'll have plenty of time to browse in the adjacent large retail outlet, which is packed with the full range of products that are made on the premises. What a great place to buy a Christmas present or two! After departing from the complex you'll head to the nearby city of Maitland. Located on the banks of the Hunter River, the area was first explored by Lieutenant-Colonel Paterson, back in 1801. He named the area Schanck's Forest Plains, however in 1933, the name was changed to Maitland. In the years that followed, Maitland became Australia's largest inland town, and the commercial heart of the prosperous Hunter Region. Consequently, due to the level of wealth that was present in the town during this time, a number of impressive buildings were constructed during this period. Today, the city is a thriving commercial centre, surrounded by both light and heavy industry, coal mines, vineyards and food production establishments. Perhaps more than any other place in Australia, the city has frequently been inundated by floodwaters from the Hunter River. It has broken its banks more than 15 times since European settlement, and in 1955, the flood was one of the most severe catastrophes to ever hit the region. It destroyed thousands of homes as the water inundated the city, and caused the deaths of 14 people. Since that time, a number of levees, spillways and channels have been constructed to help mitigate the effects of flooding. Upon arrival you'll have around 90 minutes to stroll around the shopping centre, and to have lunch in one of the city's many eating establishments. At around 1.15pm you'll depart from the City Centre to head to the nearby Grossmann House. This stunning Victorian-era home was built by the merchant Isaac Beckett between 1870-71. It adjoins the identical Brough House, which was built by Beckett's business partner, Samuel Owen. The buildings are thought to have been designed by local architect, William White. It is interesting to note that the main entrance to each residence is originally located on opposing sides, rather than at the front, to give a degree of privacy for the owners - although the two families shared a common laundry. Beckett and Owen arrived from England in 1838, and quickly diversified their High Street business to become 'General Merchants, Tailors and Woolbrokers, Wine, Spirit and Tobacco Merchants'. Between 1892 and 1963, the building housed Maitland Girls' High School, one of the first four public high schools established in New South Wales. Some changes were made to the property to accommodate the School, but in recent years the National Trust has restored the house to reflect the status and era of its Victorian owners. Gas lighting has been re-installed, and wallpapers recreated from surviving fragments. Servants' bells and a Butler's Pantry are reminiscent of the daily workings of a prosperous Victorian household. Characteristic furnishings, sourced as far as possible from the region, complete the experience. After arriving at the House at around 1.30pm, you'll be taken on a 45-Minute Guided Tour, prior to having time to explore the House at your leisure. You'll depart from the House at around 2.45pm, and head to Fighter World, which is located adjacent to the RAAF Williamtown Air Base. After arriving at around 3.25pm, you'll be given an Informative Talk about the Museum, and then have free time to wander around the very interesting exhibits. Fighter World is dedicated to preserving the proud history of fighter aircraft operations in the Royal Australian Air Force, and is a totally 'hands on' experience. Exhibited in two hangars, visitors can walk-around, touch and look into the cockpits of such famous aircraft as the Mirage III, the Avon Sabre, the Gloster Meteor - the first Vampire jet built in Australia, and new in 2013 - the mighty F-111. There is a Russian designed MiG-21 jet fighter, Hawker Hunter, WWII Spitfire replica, a Messerschmitt replica and much more. Fighter World also offers the visitor the opportunity to sit in the cockpit of a Mirage interceptor and Macchi jet trainer, and experience first-hand what it's like to be one of Australia's 'Top Gun' pilots in today's hi-tech world. From the outdoor Observation Deck you may see aircraft of the RAAFs premier Fighter Squadrons take-off and land, while listening to all the action on the live audio feed direct from the Williamtown Control Tower. You'll depart from the Museum at around 4.25pm, and return to the Hotel some five minutes later. After having time to relax and freshen up, you'll make your way into the Hotel's Mach One Restaurant, where you'll be served a delicious Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner. For Main Course you'll have the choice of either Pan-Roasted Tasmanian Salmon with Parsley Garlic Butter Potatoes, Braised Cabbage and Roast Baby Beetroot, or Rack of Roast Pork with Apple Sauce, served with Baked Potatoes, Baked Pumpkin, Steamed Greens and Gravy, or Lamb Shank Braised in Tomato & Red Wine Sauce with Steamed Potatoes and Vegetables. For Dessert, you'll have the choice of either Blueberry & Almond Tart with Mango Coulis, Mango & Pineapple Salsa, and Vanilla Ice-Cream, or White Chocolate & Pecan Tart with Camomile Poached Pear & Caramel Pecan Ice Cream, or Dark Chocolate & Brioche Bread and Butter Pudding with Vanilla Custard & Chocolate Ice Cream. Following Dinner, Tea and Coffee will be served.

After enjoying a Hot & Cold Breakfast, you'll bid farewell to the Hotel and Williamtown, and head to Hunter Valley Gardens, in Pokolbin. Following your night-time visit to see the Christmas Lights Spectacular on Sunday night, you'll now have the opportunity to visit these world-class Gardens during the day. Hunter Valley Gardens is one of the most stunning private gardens in Australia. Spanning over 60 acres, you'll be amazed by the sensational sights, colours and fragrances of the ten very striking feature gardens. Explore each garden one-by-one, and enjoy an exciting journey through the thousands of flowers, trees and shrubs. Bask in the lavish array of colours and scents found in the Rose Garden, where there are more than 8,000 roses on display; laze above the 10 metre waterfall, and take in the superb views from the lookout; or step back in time with all your favourite fairytale characters in the Storybook Garden. Along the eight kilometres of walking paths are more than six thousand trees, one million ground covers, and six hundred thousand shrubs. During your visit to the Gardens, be sure to make your way to the other side of the lake to visit the Hunter Valley Gardens Shopping Village. Situated on a flowing stream, complete with fish ponds and footpath bridges, the Village contains a wonderful range of interesting and intriguing shops. After arriving at the Gardens at around 9.15am, you'll have around two hours to stroll in the Garden, and explore the shops, prior to reboarding the coach to head to Cessnock Leagues Club, in the nearby town of Cessnock. Upon arrival, you'll sit down to a Two-Course Alternate-Drop Lunch. For Main Course you'll be served either Beer-Battered Barramundi with Chips, Salad, Tartare Sauce and Lemon, or Chicken Schnitzel with Chips, Salad and Gravy.
