Day 1: Friday 22 May 2026 – Sydney, Beresfield, Bulahdelah, Port Macquarie

Inclusions: *Porterage, Complimentary Pre-Dinner Drink, Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner, 4.5-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 7.00am and 9.00am, you'll be collected from either outside your home, or at a nearby convenient departure point (this service will be available to most people living in Sydney), and head to **Eastern Creek** and/or **Mount Colah**, where you'll have time to stretch your legs and enjoy a refreshment or two, before boarding the **5-Star Luxury Coach** for your five-day break to Port Macquarie. After collecting the Central Coast-based passengers in Warnervale, you'll head straight to the **Roadhaven Café**, in **Beresfield**, on the outskirts of Newcastle, for another rest and refreshment stop. After departing from Beresfield, you'll head to the Mid North Coast town of **Bulahdelah**. Located on the banks of the Myall River, with a population of around 1150 people, this pretty town is a popular stop off point for people travelling between Newcastle and the North Coast area. Upon arrival, you'll have around 45 minutes to stretch your legs, and enjoy a refreshment or two, prior to reboarding the coach to head to the busy city of **Port Macquarie**. Sitting on the mouth of the Hastings River, 390kms north of Sydney, this bustling city is home to over 50,000 residents. Upon arrival, you'll check-in to the 70-room, 4.5-star rated **Mercure Centro Hotel**. This quality Hotel is situated right in the heart of Port Macquarie's thriving Shopping Centre, so the city's shops and arcades are literally just a few metres away from the Hotel's front door! You won't have to worry about your luggage! It will be conveyed from the coach to your room by the Hotel's porters! After settling into your comfortable room, complete with balcony, air-conditioning and walk-in shower, you'll make your way in the lift to the Hotel's restaurant and bar, when you'll have time to enjoy a **Complimentary Pre-Dinner Drink**, prior to sitting down to a delicious **Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner**. For Main Course, you'll have the choice of either Roast Lamb with optional Mint Jelly, or Roast Pork, with optional Apple Sauce, both served with Baked Potatoes, Baked Pumpkin, Cauliflower Cheese, Steamed Peas and Gravy. The Vegetarian option will be Vegetable Risotto with Shaved Parmesan. For Dessert, you'll have the choice of either Sticky Date Pudding with Butterscotch Sauce and Vanilla Ice-Cream, or Pavlova with Berries, a Berry Coulis, and Vanilla Ice-Cream.

Day 2: Saturday 23 May 2026 – Port Macquarie, Gladstone, South Kempsey, South West Rocks, Port Macquarie

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast, Entry & Informative Talk at The Slim Dusty Centre, Complimentary Pre-Dinner Drink, Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner, 4.5-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 7.00am and 8.45am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** in the Hotel's Restaurant, prior to boarding the coach and heading north to the picturesque village of **Gladstone**. Nestled on the banks of the Macleay River, this charming little village is brimming with creativity, history and culture. Listed as a 'Creative Community' on the Mid North Coast Arts Trail, the village is home to 19 preserved historical buildings, and a number of art galleries, boutiques and cafes. Gladstone is known as the cultural heart of the Macleay Valley Coast. During your visit, be sure to pop into the '**Gladstone Hub**' – a small complex of retail outlets selling a wide variety of items such as fashion, jewellery, home décor, local produce, and refreshments. After departing from Gladstone you'll head to the **Slim Dusty Centre**. Located on the outskirts of Slim Dusty's hometown of Kempsey, this multi-purpose facility houses the *Macleay Valley Coast Visitor Information Centre*, the *Nulla Nulla Art Gallery* and the famous *Slim Dusty Museum*. Visually rich, and astonishingly varied, the Museum provides a look at the amazing life of Slim Dusty, his wife and life-long partner, Joy McKean, and their mates, touring the towns and villages of Australia's outback, and the glory days of life on the showgrounds of Australia, with artistes and performers of vaudevillian delights. You'll get an up-close look at 'Old Purple' - ZD model Ford Fairlane 500, bought new by Slim Dusty and Joy McKean in December 1971, and their last touring caravan. Slim Dusty was arguably Australia's best-known and most-loved country music singer and songwriter. He was the first Australian to have a No.1 international hit song, with 'A Pub with No Beer'. He received an unequalled 37 Golden Guitar awards, as well as two ARIA awards, and was inducted into the ARIA Hall of Fame and the Country Music Roll of Renown. At the time of his death in 2003, aged 76, Slim had been working on his 106th album. In 2007, his domestic record sales in Australia surpassed seven million. Memory acts, dental trapeze and comedy skits were all part of Slim and Joy's shows for years, until they settled into the type of performances for which they became famous; rollicking country music, and Slim's natural good humour, all with a very Australian flavour. You're sure to enjoy the costumes, the images of Australian life and its people, the music of some of Australia's finest musicians, and the insights into Australia's vast history and geography that only Slim and Joy's sixty years on the road can provide. After having a little over an hour to browse in the complex, you'll reboard the coach to head to the little town of **South West Rocks**. This pretty seaside town, with a population of around 5500 residents, is one of NSW's best-kept secrets, a little pocket of tranquility at the mouth of the Macleay River. The town boasts stunning beaches, beautiful nature trails, and a well-preserved history. Its waters attract fishermen and scuba divers from all over the world, while its string of beaches, lined with Norfolk pines, promise sun and surf without the crowds of the better-known holiday hubs. After arriving in the town at around 1.00pm, you'll have around 90 minutes to enjoy a refreshment or two in one of the towns eating venues, and to explore the nearby waterfront. At around 2.30pm you'll depart from the town to head to **Ricardo's Tomatoes**. This large commercial establishment, located just 10 minutes north of Port Macquarie, produces up to eight varieties of Tomatoes and five varieties of Strawberries, in one of the largest hydroponic farms in the state. State of the art computerised technology controls the irrigation, nutrient application, humidity, temperature and light, for around 30,000 plants growing in the two acres of greenhouses. This computer technology also controls disease, and the prevention of insects. Upon arrival at around 3.30pm, you'll have 45 minutes to browse in the complex's Farm Shop, which stocks a large range of products such as jams, sauces, relishes, pickles, chutneys, salsas, toppings, vinegars, tapenades, soups, and more! The coffee shop closes at 3.00pm, so refreshments will not be available during your visit. After departing from the complex at around 4.15pm, you'll return to the Mercure Centro Hotel at around 4.30pm. After having time to relax and freshen up, you'll head into Hotel's restaurant and

bar, to enjoy a **Complimentary Pre-Dinner Drink**, prior to sitting down to a delicious **Two-Course Pre-Ordered Dinner**. For Main Course, you'll have the choice of either Tasmanian Salmon Fillet with Potato Gratin, Steamed Greens and a Lemon Butter Sauce, or Slow Cooked Lamb Shank, served with Sweet Potato Mash, Steamed Greens, and Jus. The Vegetarian option will be Caramelised Beetroot Gnocchi in Gorgonzola Sauce, with Candied Walnuts. For Dessert, you'll have the option of either Buttermilk Panna Cotta with Raspberry Sauce, or Malteser Tiramisu with Salted Caramel Peanuts.

Day 3: Sunday 24 May 2026 – Port Macquarie & Surrounds

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast, Entry, Informative Talk, Photo with a Koala & Kangaroo Food at Billabong Zoo, Two-Hour Hastings River Afternoon Tea Cruise, Complimentary Pre-Dinner Drink, Full Choice of the Menu Dinner at Panther's Leagues Club in Port Macquarie, 4.5-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 7.00am and 8.45am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** in the Hotel's Restaurant, prior to boarding the coach at around 9.00am to head to the **Billabong Zoo**, on the outskirts of Port Macquarie. This multiple award-winning Zoo, covering around 10 acres, is home to around 200 animals, made up of 80 species of mammals, reptiles and birds. This Zoo gives you the opportunity to pat, stroke and feed a number of the animals, as well as to get considerably closer to many of the varieties of animals than you can in larger zoos. The Zoo has become world-renowned for its successful Koala breeding program. During your visit, be sure to check out some of the Zoo's most popular animals – Cheetahs, Snow Leopards, Lions, Red Pandas, Meerkats, Crocodiles, Penguins, Spider Monkeys and much, much more! If you enjoy viewing reptiles, you're also welcome to visit the specially-built reptile display. Upon arrival, you'll be given a Short Welcome Talk, a packet of Roo Feed, to feed the Kangaroos, and during your visit you'll be given the opportunity to have your photo taken with a Koala. The Zoo houses the popular Zoo Café, where you can purchase a refreshment or two during your visit, before popping into the Zoo Shop, which is packed with a range of souvenirs and wildlife-related products. You'll have around two hours to stroll around this popular tourist attraction. After departing from the Zoo, you'll head to the nearby **Vickers Fudge Shop**. This exciting shop stocks a wide range of fudge, confectionery, lollies, chocolates, peanut brittle, and also local products such as macadamia nuts, honey and much more! You'll have around 45 minutes to browse in the shop, prior to reboarding the coach to return to the Hotel. After returning to the Hotel at around 12.30pm, you'll have over 90 minutes of free time to do as you please – stroll through the nearby Port Central Shopping Mall (3 minutes on foot), walk beside the Hastings River (8 minutes on foot), or stroll to the Town Beach Lookout and Town Beach (20 minutes on foot). You are to be back waiting outside the Hotel ready to reboard the coach at 2.10pm, to head to the nearby Port Jet wharf. Upon arrival, you'll board 'Essence' – a two-level modern catamaran, for a private **Two-Hour Hastings River Afternoon Tea Cruise**. During the cruise, you'll not only view some of the beautiful natural scenery along the river, but you may also see some of the resident wildlife, such as Dolphins, Turtles, Osprey and Sea Eagles. Whilst enjoying the cruise you'll be served **Afternoon Tea**, consisting of Tea, Coffee and Biscuits. Before returning to the wharf, you'll cruise along some of the man-made canals that are home to some of Port Macquarie's most expensive homes. You'll see how the other half live! At around 4.30pm you'll return to the wharf, where you'll reboard the coach for the short journey to the nearby **Panthers Leagues Club**, for a **Full Choice of the Menu Dinner**. After arriving at the Club at around 5.00pm, you'll head into the Bistro, choose where you wish to sit, and then make your way to the bar, where you'll be served a **Complimentary Pre-Dinner Drink**. At around 5.45pm, you'll be called up one table at a time to order your Entrée and/or Main Course. Each table will be given a number, which is to be placed on your table. When your meals are ready, they'll be delivered to your table. At the completion of your Entrée and/or Main Course, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy Dessert, following the same procedure. This morning, between 6.30am and 8.15am, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** in the Hotel's Restaurant, prior to boarding the coach at around 8.45am, to depart from the Hotel and Port Macquarie. Around 30 minutes later, you'll arrive in the pretty coastal resort of **North Haven**. With a population of around 1600 residents, the town is located on the mouth of the Camden Haven Inlet, just across the bridge from the town of Laurieton. Upon arrival, you'll have around an hour to grab a coffee, go for a stroll along the banks of the Inlet, or just sit and take in the view. At around 10.15am, you'll reboard the coach and head to the busy tourist town of **Forster**. Nestled on the picturesque shores of Wallis Lake and the Pacific Ocean, Forster presents the best of the life aquatic, with boating, fishing, paddling and surfing all part of its laid-back charm. The town also makes a great base for exploring the numerous nearby national parks, and is host to many fantastic eateries and boutique breweries. The town centre's shops offer a wide range of products, including fashion, giftware, home décor, footwear, jewellery, coastal wear, and much more! You'll have around 90 minutes to browse in the shops, and to enjoy an early lunch in one of the town's many coffee shops and eating establishments. After reboarding the coach at around 1.00pm, you'll head to the nearby Boatshed No.1 wharf, where you'll board a two-level catamaran operated by Free Spirit Cruises, for a **1.5-Hour Wallis Lake Cruise**. Wallis Lake is known for its clear, unpolluted water, white sandy beaches, and diverse ecosystem, teeming with birds and wildlife. Surrounded by Wallingat National Park on the west and Booti Booti National Park on the east, the pristine waters are fed by the Wallamba River, Coolongolook River and Pipers Creek. The Lake is approximately 25 kilometres long and nine kilometres wide. During the cruise you'll only see a small portion of the Lake, however, you're still sure to enjoy what you see and experience during the cruise! Be sure to bring your camera with you – you may be lucky enough to see a dolphin swimming close to the vessel, as well as some lovely scenery to capture along the way! After reboarding the coach at around 3.15pm, you'll head straight to the **Mercure Newcastle Airport Hotel**, in Williamtown, north of Newcastle. This modern 4.5-star Hotel, consisting of 90 rooms over four levels, is located adjacent to Newcastle Airport, and the nearby Williamtown Airforce Base. Upon arrival, you'll make your way straight to your modern, well-appointed room. Shortly after arriving in your room, a porter will deliver your luggage from the coach to your room. After having over an hour to relax and freshen up, you'll make your way down the lift into the Hotel's **Mach One Restaurant**, to enjoy a **Complimentary Pre-Dinner Drink**, prior to sitting down to a

For Main Course you'll have the choice of either Rack of Roast Pork with Apple Sauce, served with Baked Potatoes, Baked Pumpkin, Steamed Greens and Gravy, or Lamb Shank Braised in Tomato & Red Wine Sauce with Steamed Potatoes and Vegetables, or Grilled Barramundi with Lemon & Parsley Sauce, Potato Gratin & Steamed Seasonal Vegetables. The Vegetarian option will be Ravioli of Eggplant & Garlic in a Brown Butter Sauce, with Pine Nuts, Oragano, Sauteed Spinach & Marinated Fetta. For Dessert, you'll have the choice of either Lemongrass & Lime Leaf Crème Brulee, with Vanilla Bean Ice Cream & Native Lemon Balm, or Dark Chocolate & Brioche Bread and Butter Pudding with Vanilla Custard & Chocolate Ice Cream, or Freshly Chopped Fruit Salad with Vanilla Ice-Cream.

Day 5: Tuesday 26 May 2026 – Williamstown, Newcastle, Sydney

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast, 2.5-Hour Newcastle Harbour Luncheon Cruise*

Between 6.30am and 8.15am this morning, you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast** in the Hotel's **Mach Restaurant**, prior to boarding the coach at around 8.30am, and departing from the Hotel. First stop will be the Farm Shop at the nearby **Medowie Macadamias**. This Shop stocks a wide and diverse variety of macadamia nuts, including plain, salted, crunchy, BBQ flavoured, white, milk or dark chocolate coated, honey coated, and flavours such as chili, curry, garlic, and hickory. The Farm Shop also stocks a range of sauces, dressings, spreads, honey, coffee, nut crackers, cooking oil, and much more! After arriving at around 8.45am, you'll have around 45 minutes to browse in the Farm Shop – you're sure to be tempted into making a purchase! After reboarding the coach at around 9.30am, you'll head straight to **Newcastle Harbour**, where after some free time to stroll around the Harbourfront, you'll board the Nova Cruises catamaran for a **2.5-Hour Newcastle Harbour Luncheon Cruise**. After departing from the wharf at around 10.45am, you'll spend the next 2½ hours taking in the sights and sounds in this busy port. Newcastle Harbour is home to the largest port on the East Coast, and is Australia's oldest export port. It is a vital economic gateway to the resource-rich Hunter Valley, and the north and northwest of NSW. With over 2,200 trade vessels visiting the port each year, the Harbour is one of the largest tonnage throughput ports in the country, exporting valuable bulk cargo such as coal, grain, vegetable oils, alumina, fertiliser and ore concentrates to markets overseas. During the Cruise you'll be served a delicious **Two-Course Buffet Lunch**. The Buffet's Main Course options will include Leg Ham, carved from the bone, Seasoned Roast Chicken, fresh local King Prawns, Coleslaw, Potato Salad, and a Green Leaf Salad with Balsamic Dressing. For Dessert, you'll be served a tempting selection of Petit Fours, followed by Tea or Coffee. At the completion of the Cruise at around 1.30pm, you'll reboard the coach, to commence the journey home.
